

Books In Print/Global Books In Print Bindery Definitions for Advanced Searching

| Code Description | Category | Definition |
|--------------------------------------|------------------|--|
| Apple II disk | Software | Disk that holds data (primarily used on an Apple II computer) |
| Audio Cassette | Audio Cassette | Book that is recorded on a standard audio cassette |
| Bath Book | Book, Other | Book bound in vinyl; typically used for children's books for use in the bathtub |
| Board Books | Book, Other | Book that is bound with cardboard (commonly used for children's books) |
| Video, Betamax | Video, Other | A video recorded for use in a Sony Betamax machine (an early video format) |
| Box or Slipcased | Book, Other | Book is boxed slipcased or casebound for protection |
| Compact Disc | Compact Disc | Data is stored on a compact disc |
| CD-ROM | Software | Data is put on a compact disc for use in a computer |
| Cloth Text | Hardcover | A hardcover textbook |
| 3.5 Diskette | Software | Data is put on a 3.5" inch diskette to be used in a computer |
| Diskette | Software | Data is put onto disk by electro magnetic means (also called a floppy disk) |
| DVD | Video DVD | DVD originally stood for Digital Video Disc but now has come to mean Digital Versatile Disc as the format has become more inclusive |
| E-Book | E-book | Electronic Book. E-books can be downloaded to a personal computer or, in some cases, to a device such as Palm Pilot or Rocket E-Book |
| Fiche | Microfilm, Other | Microfiche. Found primarily in libraries. Used extensively in archival work and for older, out of print titles available on demand. |
| Filmstrip | Film, Other | A series of separate images, sometimes with sound, that are projected individually onto film. |
| 1.44M, 3.5 Disk, DOS | Software | 3.5 inch disk that holds 1.44 megabytes of data, used in computers |
| 1.2M, 5.25 Disk, DOS | Software | 5.25 inch disk that holds 1.2 megabytes of data, used in computers |
| Imitation Leather | Hardcover | Book is bound in faux leather |
| Kivar (or like) | Softcover | Book is bound in a pyroxlin coated, 10 point cover material or something similar |
| 720K, 3.5 Disk, DOS | Software | 3.5 inch disk that holds 720 kilobytes of data, used in computers |
| 360K, 5.25 Disk, DOS | Software | 5.25 inch disk that holds 360 kilobytes of data, used in computers |
| Library Binding | Hardcover | Hardcover book with a protective plastic slipcover and reinforced spine, used by libraries |
| Leather | Hardcover | Book is bound in real leather |
| LP Record | Audio, other | Data is stored on a long playing record album |
| Microfilm | Microfilm | Information - such as newspapers or periodicals - stored on microfilm; frequently for archival use |
| 1.44M, Mac | Software | Disk that holds 1.44 megabytes of data that is used in Apple computers |
| 800K, Mac | Software | Disk that holds 800 kilobytes of data that is used in Apple computers |
| Mass Market | Mass Market | Small paperbound books with a print run of 1000 or more; sold in various retail outlets |
| Microform | Microfilm, Other | Technique that reduces the size of a printed page to save space and cost |
| NTSC | Video, Other | "National Television Standards Committee", television transmission & video recording |
| Otabind | Softcover | Book whose binding enables it to lay flat so as to prevent damage to the spine |
| Perfect | Softcover | Fastening loose pages into a solid book with adhesive and gluing it to the cover |
| PALM | Video, Other | Video format used in Brazil |
| Pop Up | Hardcover | Book with 3-D pages that stand up when the book is opened |

| Paper Text | Softcover | Soft covered textbook |
| Ringbound | Book, Other | Sides of book are made with rings so that pages go through the rings |
| Slides | Film, Other | Individual picture frames to be used on a projector and viewed on a screen |
| Spiral | Softcover | Side of book have small wire rings that hold the pages together |
| Tape Reel (Audio, not computer tape) | Audio, other | Tape style audiocassette that goes on a reel to reel |
| Trade Cloth | Hardcover | Book bound with a hard cover; the majority of hard cover general trade works have this binding |
| Trade Paper | Softcover | Books bound with a paper cover; higher priced book than mass market & sold through trade channels; the majority of paper cover general trade works have this binding. |
| Transparencies | Film, Other | Transparent sheets of paper used on an overhead projector. |
| 35MM | Film, Other | Standard type of film used in professional film making (highest quality) |
| Video, 8mm | Video, Other | Narrowest type of film; largely used for amateur photography & educational films |
| Vinyl Bound | Softcover | Book bound in vinyl (or similar plastic material) |
| Video, VHS Format | Video, VHS | Cartridge that holds videotape for recording & playback |
| SECAM | Video, Other | "Sequential Couleur Avec Memoire"; video format where color is transmitted sequentially. |
| Film, 16mm | Film, Other | Most popular and easiest type of film to use, found in documentaries and independent films. |
| Video Disc | Video, Other | A disk on which images and sound are recorded and played back on a TV screen |
| PAL | Video, Other | Video format used in Europe that has better quality and color image than in the USA |
| Video, Super VHS | Video, Other | Videocassette tape with greater resolution & quality than standard VHS. |
| Video, 3/4 U-Matic | Video, Other | Early 1970's video cartridge that was also used for audio mixing. |
