

**AWARDS**

Search 400 major book, audio, and movie awards from 10 countries by selecting the letter of the alphabet for the award you need, or browse by subject, such as cook books, and see only awards in that category.

Filling in the search fields above the Awards list will bring you directly to **Search Results**, while selecting **Awards** in the list below enables you to scroll through all winners of that award by year.

When you select an award through the alphabetical list you will come to a description of the award and an extensive listing of award winners, finalist and nominees over the past several years. Selecting a link on this list will bring you to Search Results. For a movie, the Author category contains the Performer. Select a title for the Full Description including details such as, for a movie, its rating, running time, and distribution information.

**BESTSELLERS**

For a list of *Publishers Weekly* Bestsellers in any year, simply type the year in “**Over A Century of Publishers Weekly\* Bestsellers.**” Search bestseller lists since 1895 and read “**Year At A Glance**” notes.

In **Bowker’s Bestsellers Database** use search criteria to look for bestselling titles. Select a Bestseller List to browse all titles which appeared on that list. Or search for specific titles by selecting a Bestseller List from the drop down menu plus other optional criteria, such as Author/Contributor, Keyword in Subject, or Keyword in Title.

**AUTHOR INFORMATION**

Click on the **Bio’s** tab on the top navigation bar. Enter an author’s name (or other contributor, such as an illustrator or editor). Unsure of the exact name or spelling? Select an alphabetic choice to browse names.

View detailed information, including, if available: a biography (or more than one), a link to their personal website, the author’s e-mail address, and links to their other works.
